April 19, 2004

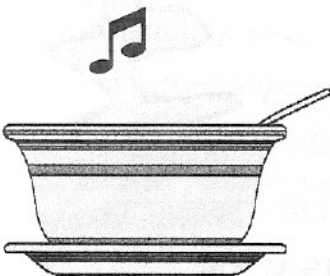
